WHAT'S GOING ON WITH THE MR LOTS?

Competing Interests and Requirements:

- Clean-Up of Overgrown Properties
- Community Safety and FireSmart Focus
- Trend Toward Multi-Use Functionality of Municipal Lands

In 2023 Council Recognized These Competing Priorities

- Decision to Focus on Reserve Rehabilitation in 2023/2024
- Develop a Mooring Strategy and Lot Conceptual Designs

FOCUS OF MR REHABILITATION PROJECT:

A) Focus on MR 3, 8 & 9

- Others have recently had extensive work done (2018)
- These select lots are increasingly "multi-purpose" in nature

B) Remove Overgrowth and Underbrush

- Reduce Fuel Load but preserve the Spruce Trees
- Maximize Open Space for Community Use
- Reset the Maintenance Clock

C) Replace the Fence

- Security and Limited Access.
- Perhaps introduce a walking trail concept

D) Landscape and Vegetation Replacement

- Maximize Space and Make Maintenance Manageable
- Reintroduce FireSmart Approved Trees and Shrubs
- Reseed space to grass, perhaps add hardscape.

E) Shoreline and Mooring Rehabilitation

- Subject to Permit Approval*
- Grade Northern section of the lots down to shoreline
- Make as much "usable" shoreline as possible,
- Install riprap to preserve for the future
- Install demarcation plaques/signs for each approved mooring site
